

Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters

Juniata County

May 21, 2019 Municipal Primary

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on May 21, 2019 in Juniata County. Military and Overseas electors may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.votespa.com, www.fvap.gov, or this website. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (717)436-7706 or by email to eweyrich@juniataco.org.

Military and Overseas electors may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot, available at www.fvap.gov and this website. Military electors may use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

The FWAB can be used to vote for ALL Federal, State, And Local Offices and Ballot Initiatives.

To vote, refer to the instructions and page 3 of the FWAB application.

To vote for Federal Offices (President, U.S. Senator, or U.S. Representative in Congress), write in the name of the candidate of your choice in the space provided on the FWAB.

To vote for State Offices, Local Offices or Ballot Initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation, or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write YES or NO.
