

ELECTION PROCLAMATION

Notice is hereby given to the voters of Juniata County that the General Election will be held in said County on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 between the hours of 7:00 AM and 8:00 PM prevailing time at the regular polling places in each of the 18 election districts in said county at which time and place, candidates representing the several political parties are to be nominated/voted.

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER:

To vote you must blacken the oval completely. An oval blackened to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.

To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, you must blacken the oval completely to the left of the line provided, and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.

Mark ballot only with a medium point black pen. Your ballot will be counted by an optical scanner and if you use anything else it may not be readable by the scanner. If you make a mistake, do not erase, ask for a new ballot.

WARNING: If you receive and absentee or mail-in ballot and return your voted ballot by the deadline, you may not vote at your polling place on election day. If you are unable to return your voted absentee or mail-in ballot by the deadline, you may only vote a provisional ballot at your polling place on election day, unless you surrender your absentee or mail-in ballot and envelope to the judge of elections to be voided to vote by regular ballot.
