1. Listen to a presentation by the Juniata County Veterans Affairs Director Dennis Hutchings.
 2. Approve a request from the local tax collectors to increase the per slip compensation for real estate tax bills by 3% annually for four years beginning in 2022.
 3. Approve the tax exonerations for Turbett and Walker Townships as per the material provided.
 4. Approve the "Purchase of Service Agreement" between Juniata County Children and Youth Services, the Juniata County Probation Department, and the Summit Academy. The agreement shall be in force and effect from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.
 5. Approve the following "Purchase of Service Agreements" as submitted by the Children & Youth Fiscal department. The terms for the agreements are July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.
 - o Justice Works YouthCare – Placement Transition Program services as cost of \$80.00 per hour in addition to Visit Coaching Program services at a cost of \$75.00 per hour.
 - o Miffin-Juniata Human Services – Implementation of the Juniata County Communities that Care Grant through the Juniata County Violence Prevention Board at a cost not to exceed \$56,083.48.

II. Salary Board

1. Approve hiring Daniel L. Ames as a part-time County Detective within the District Attorney's Office effective January 26, 2021 as requested by Cory J. Snook, District Attorney. The position is classified at less than 1000 hours per year and is not eligible for benefits including the County's Retirement Fund as outlined in the Juniata County Employee's Retirement System Summary Plan. The hourly wage shall be \$21.77 and shall be funded through grants via the District Attorney's Office in addition to an annual contribution from the County's general fund.
