Approve the "Child Welfare Information Solution" (CWIS) Data Sharing Agreement between Juniata County Government on behalf of Juniata County Children and Youth Services and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 as recommended by Ashley J. Baxter Children & Youth Director.

1. Approval of the July 26, 2022 Minutes.
2. Approve the creation of one additional casual, part-time position within the Commissioner's Office to provide security services as needed. These positions are classified at less than 1000 hours per year and are not eligible for benefits nor are they part of the County's Retirement Fund as outlined in the Juniata County Employee's Retirement System Summary Plan.
3. Approve the hiring of Adam C. Coder as a casual, part-time employee within the Commissioner's Office to provide security services as needed and set the hourly wage at \$18.46 for a non-certified status. This position is classified at less than 1000 hours per year and are not eligible for benefits nor are they part of the County's Retirement Fund as outlined in the Juniata County Employee's Retirement System Summary Plan.
4. Acknowledge the hiring of Sonja M. Ciccolini to fill the full-time Office Manager position with the within the Juniata County Sheriff's Office effective August 15, 2022. The hourly wage will be \$17.09 which reflects past experience and special certifications.
