1. Approve projects and allocations for Federal Fiscal Year 2023 CDBG funding as presented.
 2. Adopt the following resolutions as they pertain to the Federal Fiscal Year 2023 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

II. Salary Board

1. Approve the hiring of Jay Borman as casual, part-time 911 Telecommunicators within the 911 Communications Center as recommended by Allen Weaver, Emergency Management Agency Director. This position is classified as “part-time” at less than 1000 hours per year and, as such, does not qualify for any benefits including membership in the County’s Retirement Fund as outlined in the Juniata County Employee’s Retirement System Plan. Wages will be as per the current bargaining unit contract.
