

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill, and Mark Partner present. Also in attendance in the meeting room were Deputy Director of Fiscal Management Leah Strawser, Grants Manager Lisa Stalnaker, and Juniata County Crop Walk representatives, Hannah H. Bashore, Becky Zeigler, and Graham C. Fowler. Participating via WebEx was one unidentified member of the public.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Graybill and a second by Partner, the Minutes of the August 10, 2021 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

During public comment, Graham Fowler presented the following statement:

“I stand before you, the illustrious Juniata County Commissioners, to humbly request that you issue a proclamation declaring the week of October 4-10 "Hunger Action Week."

When the Israelites wandered in the wilderness for 40 years, each night they went to bed with an empty cupboard, trusting that in the morning God would provide manna for them to eat. Yearly statistics show that 10% of Juniata County residents today are "food insecure." That means that, like the Israelites, they go to bed uncertain whether they will be able to eat the next day, or in the weeks to come. Except that God does not provide them manna in the morning. Instead, God calls on each of us to help our neighbor.

That's why we would like you to declare October 4-10 "Hunger Action Week." It would be a week to draw people's attention to food insecurity in our county and to invite residents to take action against hunger: by donating money or food to local ministries like the Juniata County Food Pantry and the Meals on Wheels Program and by committing themselves to volunteer in these ministries, like stocking shelves, cooking or delivering meals, or helping at satellite food pantry sites.

The culmination of the "Hunger Action Week" will be the annual Juniata County CROP Walk on Sunday, October 10. This will be the 49<sup>th</sup> CROP Walk in Juniata County. Over the years this walk has raised almost \$550,000, which has been used to support hunger ministries in the United States and throughout the world through the work of Church World Service. Each year, 25% of the money raised stays right here in Juniata County and supports the Food Pantry and Meals on Wheels programs. We would like to use this week to encourage everyone to participate in the CROP Walk, either by walking or by making a donation to a walker. And we would like to encourage you, the commissioners, to form your own team and join us in the CROP Walk.

Thank you for your time, and for considering our request to issue the proclamation declaring October 4-10 "Hunger Action Week."
