The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill, and Mark Partner present. Also attending was Assessment and GIS Director Michael J. Hower. Participating via WebEx conference call were Sentinel reporter Jordan Fortson and Juniata Sentinel reporter Leslie Milliken.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Graybill and a second by Partner, the Minutes of the August 16, 2022 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to adopt Ordinance No. 2022-1A “Amending Ordinance No. 2022-1 Establishing a Uniform Parcel Identifier System by Providing for a Depository Agency of the County's Tax Maps, including Additions, Deletions, and Revisions of such Maps and by Providing for the Assignment by Such Agency of Uniform Parcel Identifiers for Each Parcel on the Map in Order to Facilitate Conveyancing and to Establish a Modern Land Records System”. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the “Purchase of Service Agreement” between the Juniata County Commissioners on behalf of the Juniata County Children and Youth Social Services Agency and Madelyn R. Armstrong at an hourly rate of \$20.00 to perform such duties as may be reasonably assigned. The agreement shall be in effect from August 18, 2022 through June 30, 2023 or until services are no longer required, whichever occurs first. The motion was unanimously carried.
