The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill, and Mark Partner present. Others in attendance in the meeting room included Sentinel reporter Tyler Rupert, Planning and Community Development Director Bradley W. Kerstetter, Seda-Cog representative Heather Weisen, McAlisterville Area Joint Authority (MAJA) manager Cory Fronk, and MAJA engineer Brian Book. Participating via WebEx conference call was Juniata Sentinel reporter Leslie Milliken.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Graybill and a second by Partner, the Minutes of the June 7, 2022 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

- The Commissioners listened to an update by Heather Weisen regarding the McAlisterville Area Spring Rehabilitation Project. Newly awarded competitive funding in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 will be used for a new well and tank. Following Ms. Weisen’s presentation, Cory Fronk thanked everyone who has supported the project.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve “Professional and Administrative Services Agreement” between Juniata County and SEDA-Council of Governments (SEDA-COG) for the administration of the Competitive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2021, on behalf of the McAlisterville Area Spring Rehabilitation Project. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the following “Purchase of Service Agreements” between Juniata County Children and Youth Services, the Juniata County Probation Department, and the entities listed. Unless otherwise noted, the agreements shall be in force and effect from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. The motion was unanimously carried.

- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve the tax exonerations for Lack Township and Mifflintown and Thompsontown Boroughs as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve the submission of the “Notice of Intent – Requesting Election Security Grant Funds”. Juniata County’s entitlement is \$2,000.00. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to appoint Stephanie Diem of 850 Jones, Road, Mifflintown to a three-year term on the Juniata County Library Board of Trustees. Ms. Diem, who replaces Marsh Harris, will serve on the Board from June 7, 2022 through June 6, 2025. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve payment of checks #64809 - #64873 in the amount of \$160,311.79. The motion was unanimously carried.
- The Commissioners reviewed the following May 2022 departmental report:
 - “Juniata County Probation’s Monthly Activities Report” as submitted by Michelle A. Beaver, Chief Probation Officer.
