

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray and Mark Partner present. Also attending were McAlisterville Area Joint Authority (MAJA) manager Cory Fronk, cb3 Solutions engineer Brian Book, Port Royal Borough representative Gladys M. Boyer, and Juniata County Library Director Vince Giordano. Participating via WebEx conference call were Community Development Director Bradley W. Kerstetter, SEDA Council of Governments (SEDA-COG) representative Heather Kelly-Weisen, Court Administrator Christina L. Zook, and four unidentified members of the public.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Gray and a second by Partner, the Minutes of the June 8, 2021 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

During public comment, the following individuals spoke:
