

June 8, 2021

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray and Mark Partner present. Also attending were Nestler College Scholarship recipients Jadyne Martin and Kathryn Hart, Jadyne's mother Tammy Martin, Community Development Director Bradley W. Kerstetter, and Tuscarora Amateur Radio Association representatives Donald Walters, Nancy Walters, Andrew Baer, and Lori Walters. Participating via WebEx conference call were two unidentified members of the public.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Gray and a second by Partner, the Minutes of the May 25, 2021 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:
