## Q6 Please rate how prepared you and your household are for the probable impacts of natural hazard events likely to occur within the county?

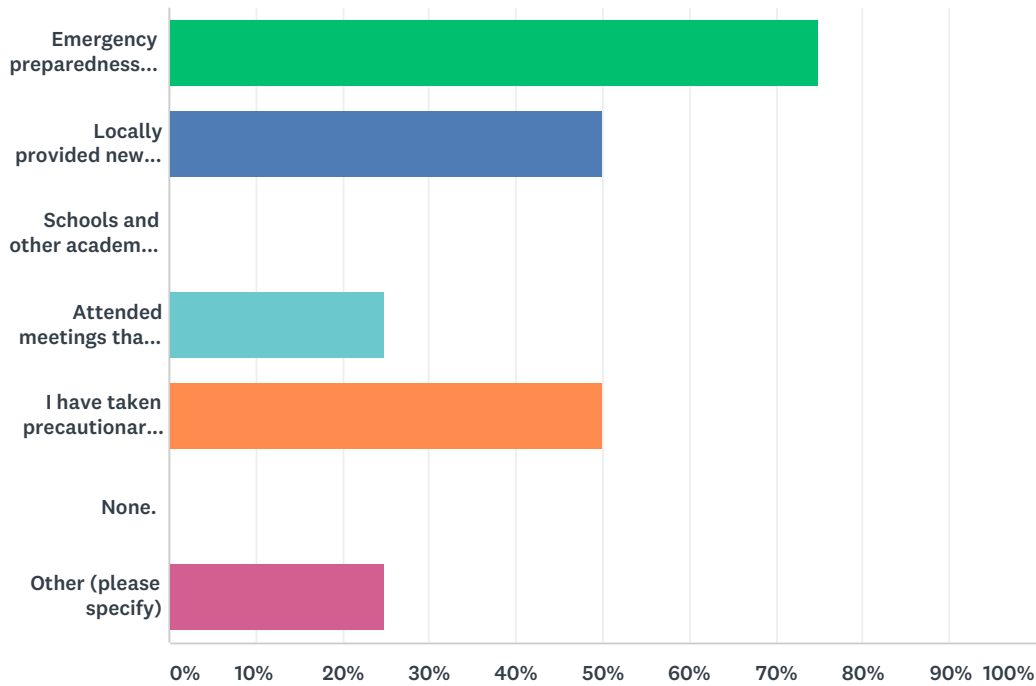

## Q10 To the best of your knowledge is your property located in a designated floodplain?

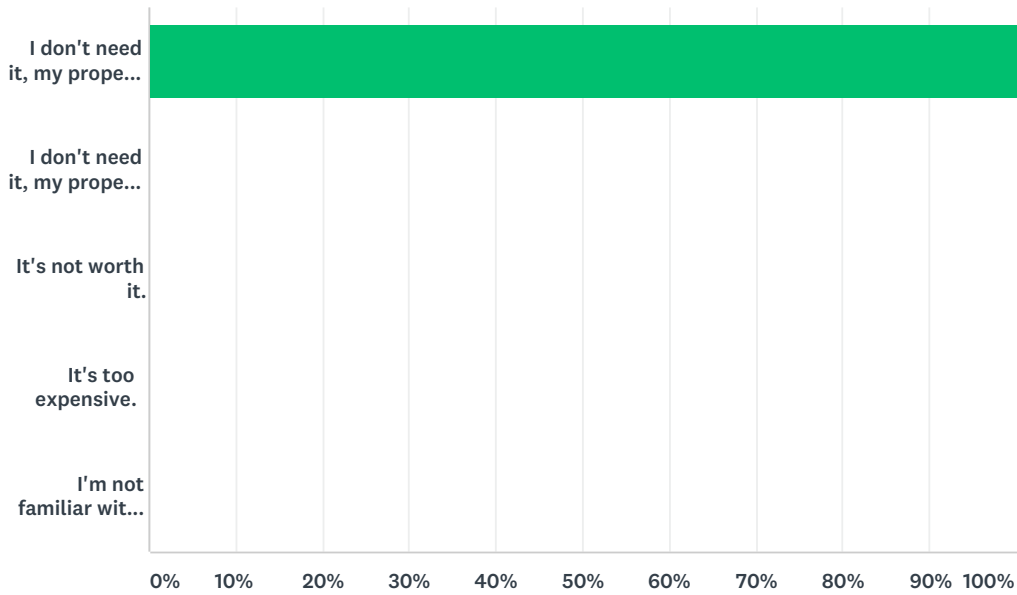

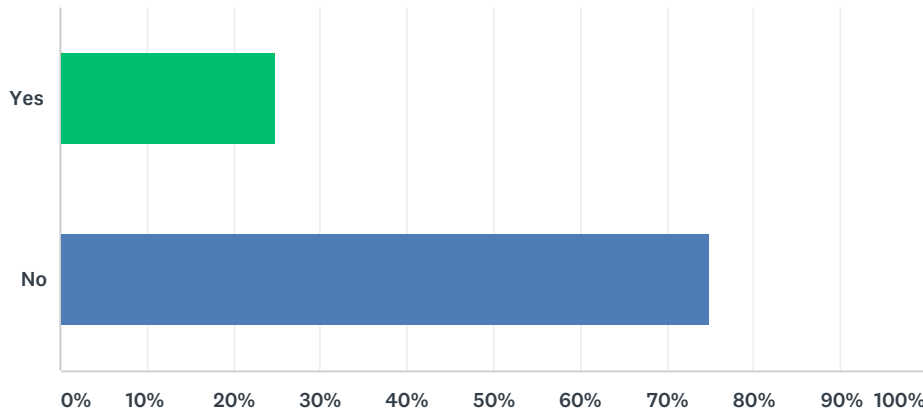

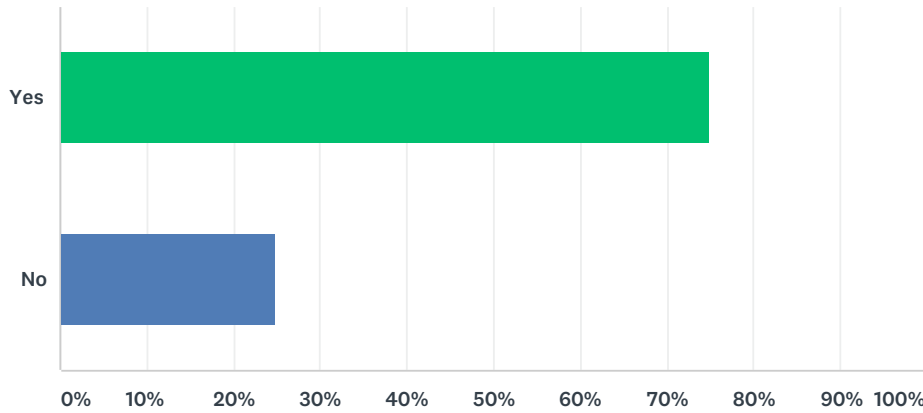

### Q14 Would the disclosure of this type of information influence your decision to purchase/move into a home?

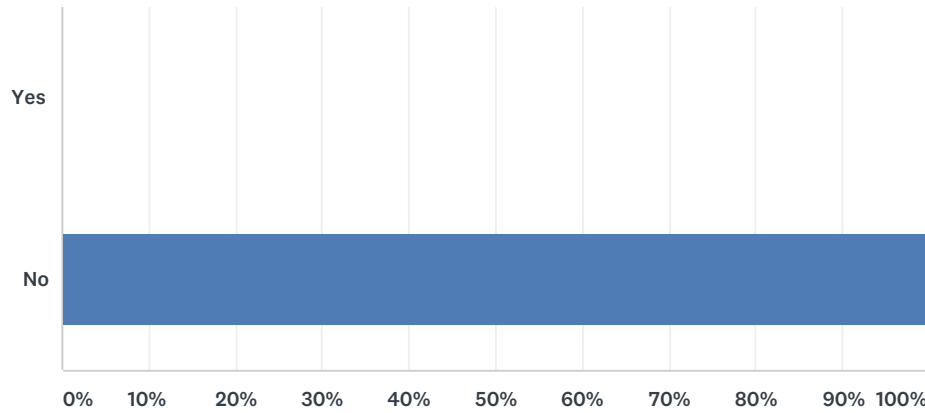

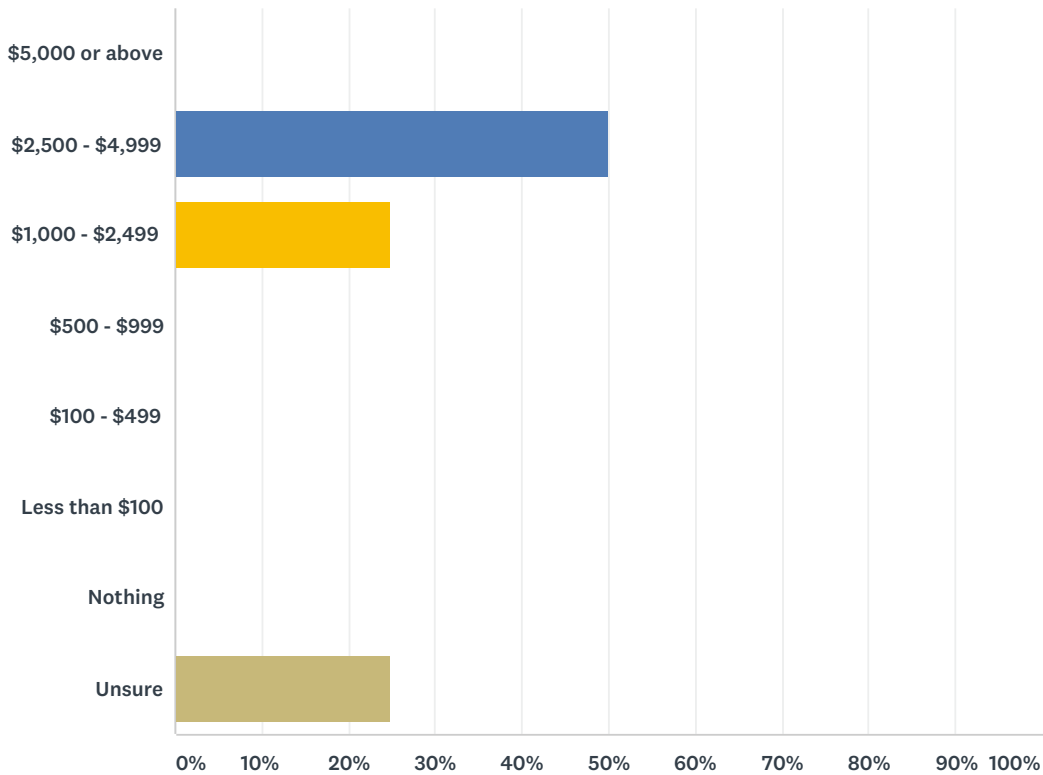
