Special Meeting

The Juniata County Commissioners held a special meeting on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill, and Mark Partner present. Also in attendance in the meeting room were Times reporter Paulette Forry, and County Coroner Lee E. Snyder. Participating via WebEx conference call were Sentinel reporter Tyler Rupert and two unidentified members of the public.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairperson Gray.

During public comment, Lee Snyder asked the Commissioners to consider raising the base salary for the Coroner. Mr. Snyder cited increased call volumes and regulatory mandates as the reasons for his request. At the end of the discussion, it was agreed that Mr. Snyder would submit a proposal for consideration no later than August 2022.

There being no further public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to adopt Resolution 2022-6 “Fixing Salaries of County Officers”-specifically a County Commissioner, Sheriff, Treasurer, Prothonotary and Clerk of Courts, Recorder of Deeds, Register of Wills and Clerk of Orphans Court, Coroner, and County Auditor - pursuant to the provisions of law codified at 16 P.S. 11011-10.1 et. Seq.

For calendar year 2026, the salaries as set forth by the Juniata County Board of Commissioners Resolution No. 2018-8 for the calendar year 2025 shall be adjusted by plus three and one-half percent (3.50%);  
For calendar year 2027, the salaries for 2026, plus two percent (2.00%) of the salaries for 2026;  
For calendar year 2028, the salaries for 2027, plus two percent (2.00%) of the salaries for 2027;  
For calendar year 2029, the salaries for 2028, plus two percent (2.00%) of the salaries for 2028.

A roll call vote was called for and the motion passed as follows:

There being no further business, it was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to adjourn at 6:14 p.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
