The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill, and Mark Partner present. Also present in the meeting room was Community Development Director Bradley W. Kerstetter. Participating via WebEx conference call were Children and Youth Services Supervisor Jeff Moore and three unidentified members of the public.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Partner and a second by Graybill, the Minutes of the March 16, 2021 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- Chairperson Gray provided an informational update regarding plans for a COVID-19 mass vaccination clinic. A formal plan has been submitted to PEMA and specific details regarding a clinic will be released to the public as they become available.
- The Commissioners issued Proclamation No. 2021-1 proclaiming the April 2021 as “April is Child Abuse Prevention Month”. Children and Youth Services Supervisor Jeff Moore provided a brief update on CYS operations and ongoing strategies to prevent child abuse.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to ratify a “Letter of Support” for the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy regarding a proposed Juniata Watershed Management Plan Update. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 “State Offender Supervision Fund Grant-In-Aid Agreement”, Subgrant #35695, as recommended by Michelle A. Beaver, Chief Probation Officer. This agreement is a one-year renewal for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the use of the County Records Improvement Fund to purchase Adobe Illustrator and Photoshop at a total cost of \$878.88 for the Veterans Affairs office as requested by Dennis R. Hutchings, Veterans Affairs Director. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to ratify the Certificate of Cost Allocation Plan for Fiscal Year 2019 as submitted by Maximus. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the “Certification Statements - County Children & Youth Social Service Programs” for the periods of July 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020 and October 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 as submitted by the Children & Youth Fiscal Department. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve the tax exonerations for Fermanagh Township and Mifflin Borough as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to ratify payment of checks #60808 - #60856 in the amount of \$170,987.16. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve payment of checks #60857 - #60886 in the amount of \$111,978.09. The motion was unanimously carried.
