Gov. Wolf Announces Available Aid Following Record-Shattering Summer Rains

Governor Tom Wolf declared a weather-related disaster in Bradford, Columbia, Delaware, Northumberland, Schuylkill and Susquehanna counties after significant flood damage was sustained from severe storms in mid-August.

Homes and businesses that sustained damage in neighboring counties are also eligible for assistance. Storm damage was widespread as properties in 26 counties, including Juniata County, were affected. Individuals and businesses may be able to receive aid in the form of low-interest loans from the Small Business Administration. Anyone experiencing property damage is encouraged to apply.
