The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill, and Mark Partner present. Also attending were Juniata River Valley Visitors Bureau representatives, Jenny Landis, Jenna Stoner, and Buffie Boyer. Participating via WebEx conference call were Sentinel reporter Jordan Fortson, Juniata Sentinel reporter Leslie Milliken and 911 Communications Supervisor Adam Waite.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Partner and a second by Graybill, the Minutes of the August 30, 2022 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

- The Commissioners listened to a presentation from Jenny Landis of the Juniata River Valley Visitors Bureau regarding Goose Day.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve Johnathan D. Hershey as an unpaid intern during the fall semester in the District Attorney’s office effective September 1, 2022 as recommended by Cory Snook, District Attorney. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve a “Letter of Support” endorsing FirstLight’s “National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) Middle Mile Grant” application to obtain funding to create access to high quality connectivity services. This project is the result of a partnership between Centre WISP and FirstLight. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the use of the County Records Improvement Fund to purchase one (1) Chief 4- 7mFP Floor Stand at a total cost of \$971.99 to hold an additional large monitor at the Courthouse public entrance security check point as recommended by S.
